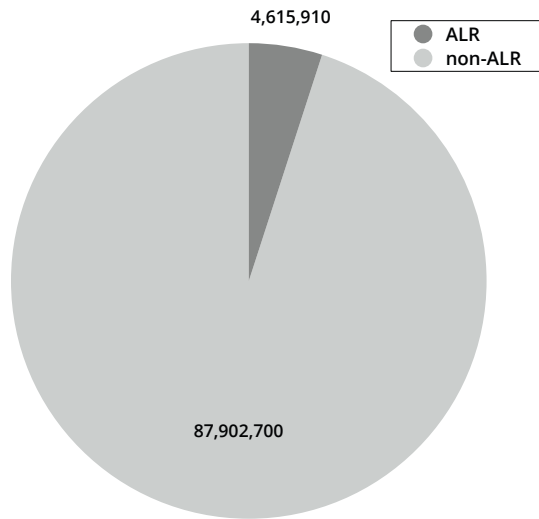


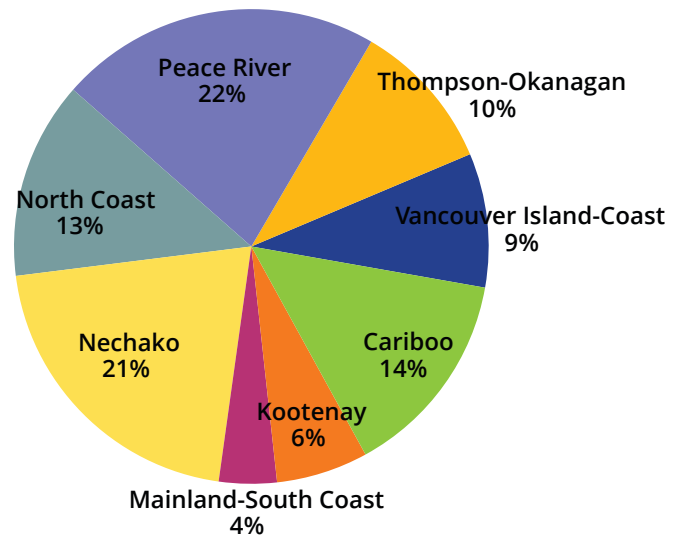

(92,518,600 hectares)

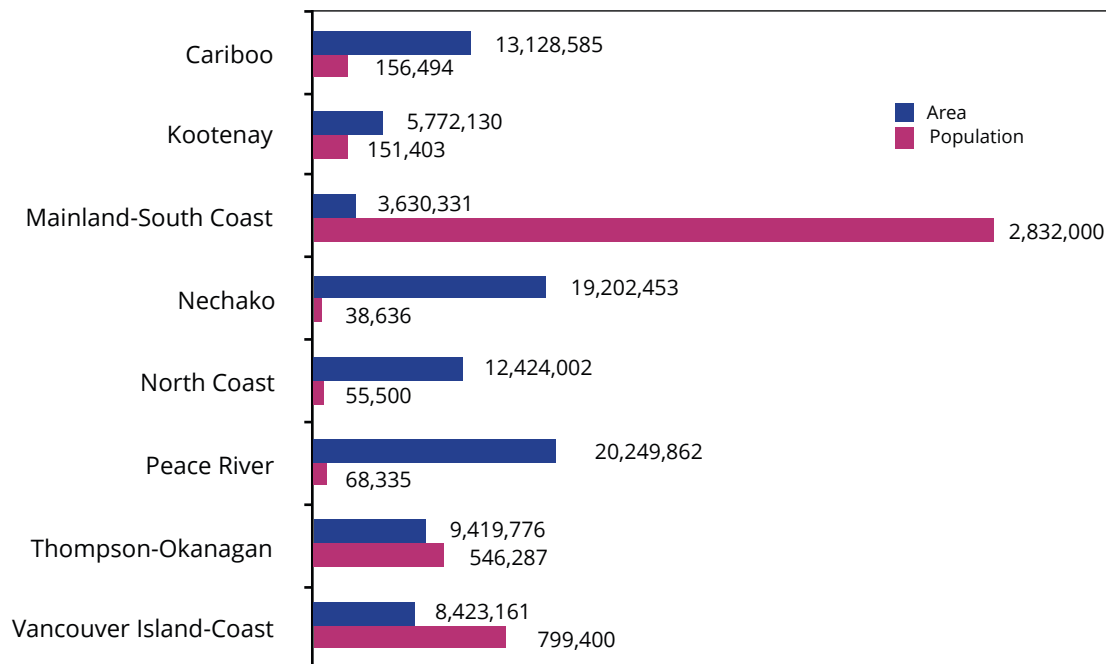


Total Land Area (by region)
(92,518,600 hectares)

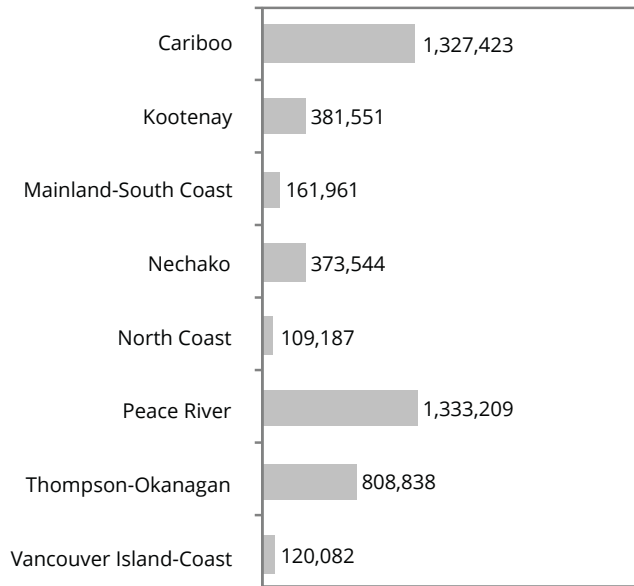


Total Land & Population (by region)

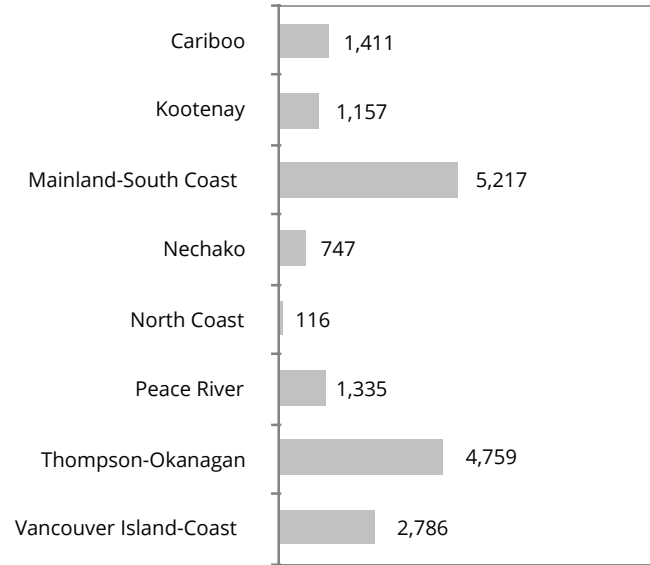

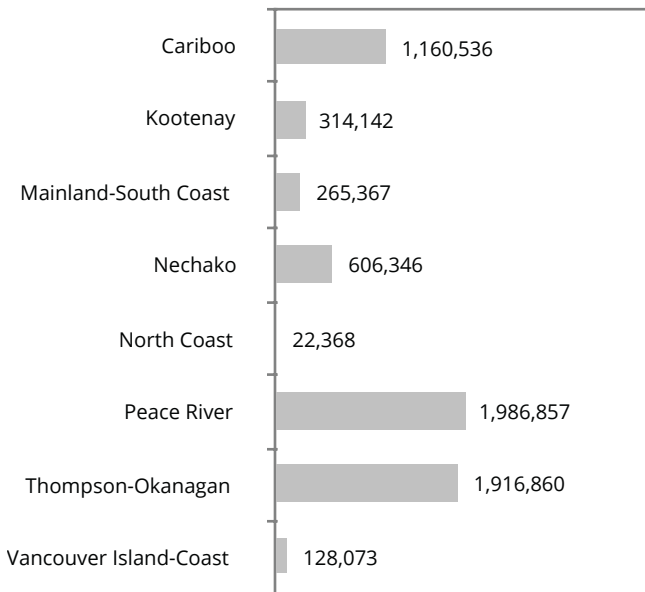

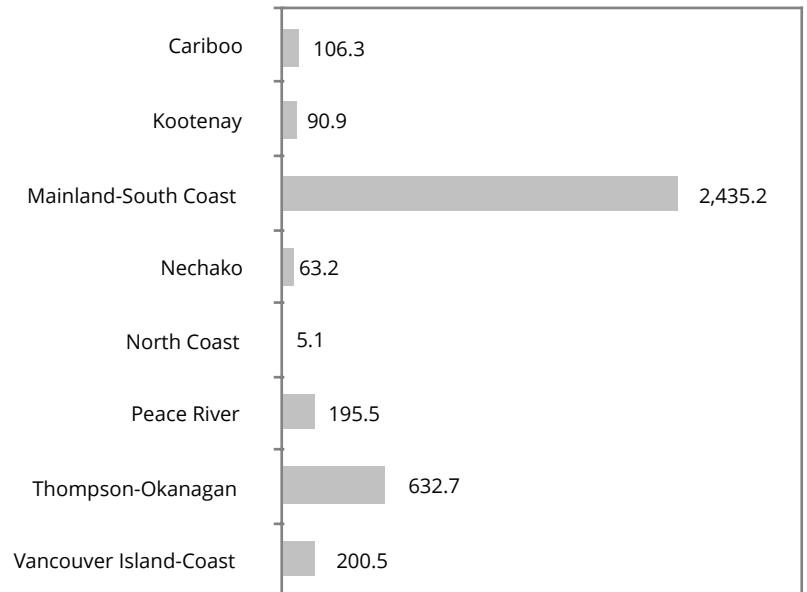


As the ALR has inclusions and exclusions throughout the year the total of the regional hectares does not equal the BC total as they were extracted from the ALC database at different times.

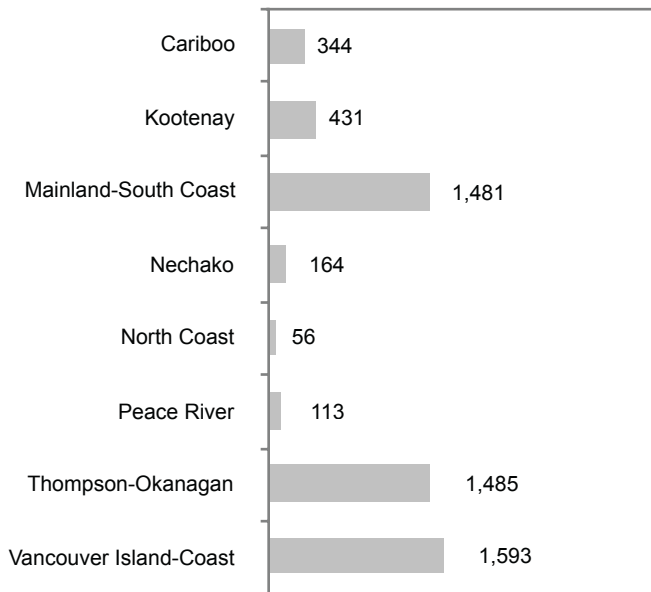
Total Area of Farms (hectares)

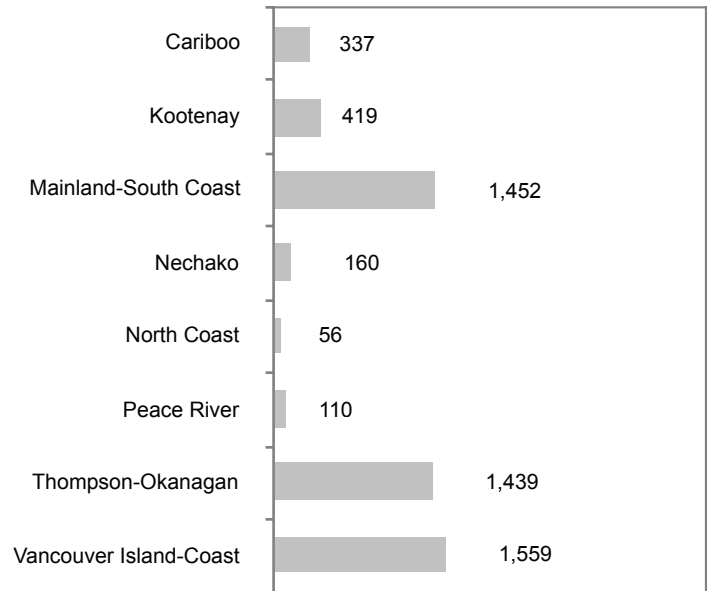
Total Gross Farm Receipts (\$millions)

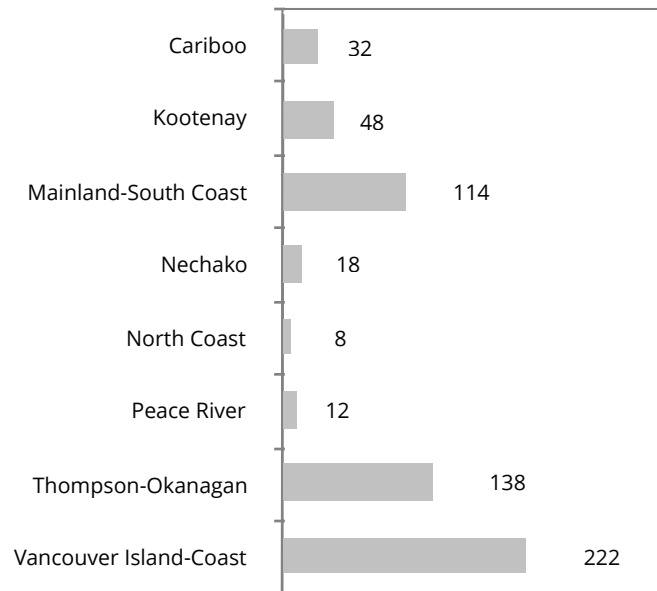
Selling Directly to Consumers (farm counts)

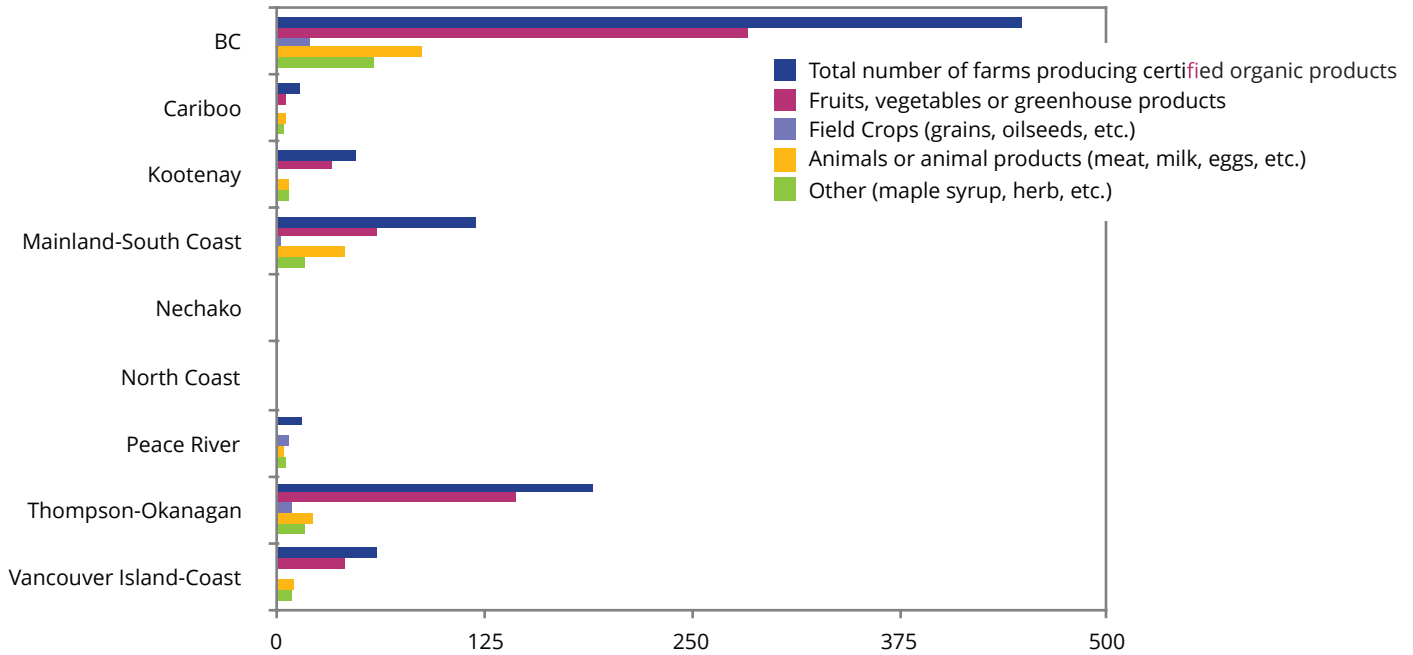
Selling Unprocessed Agricultural Products Directly to Consumers (farm counts)

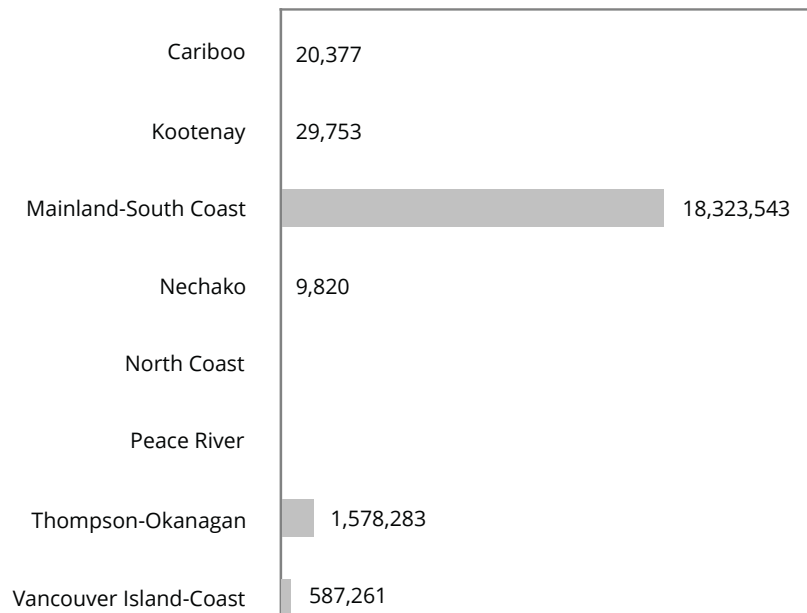


Farms classified by Certified Organic Products (farm counts)



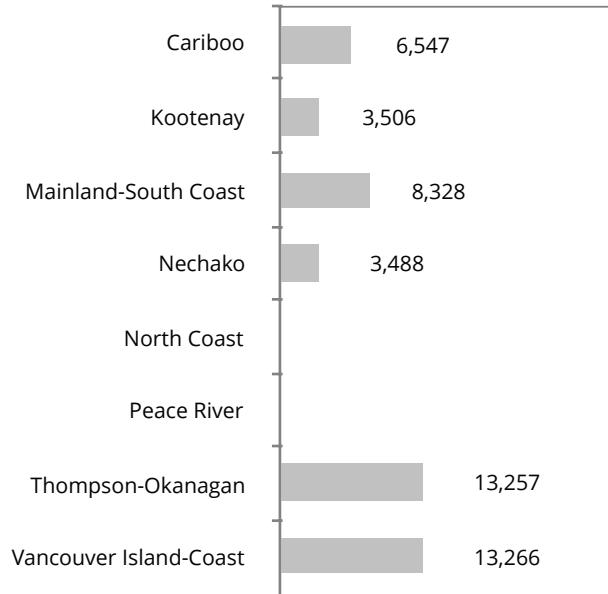
Hens and Chickens (number of animals)

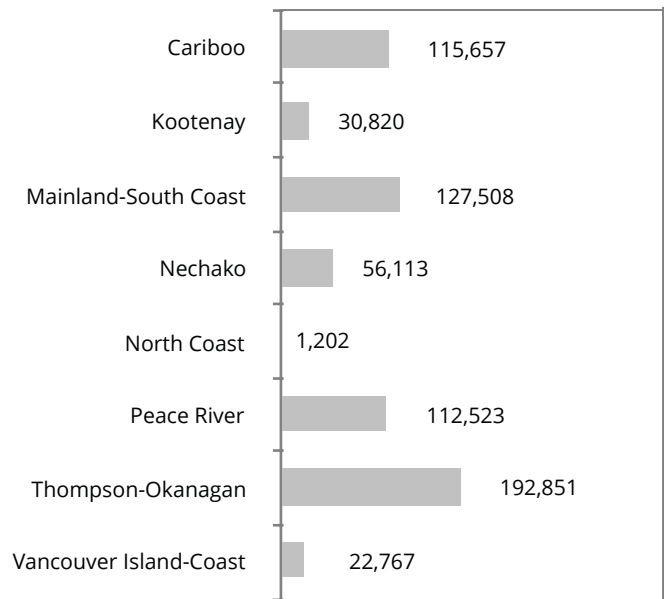
Sheep and Lambs (number of animals)

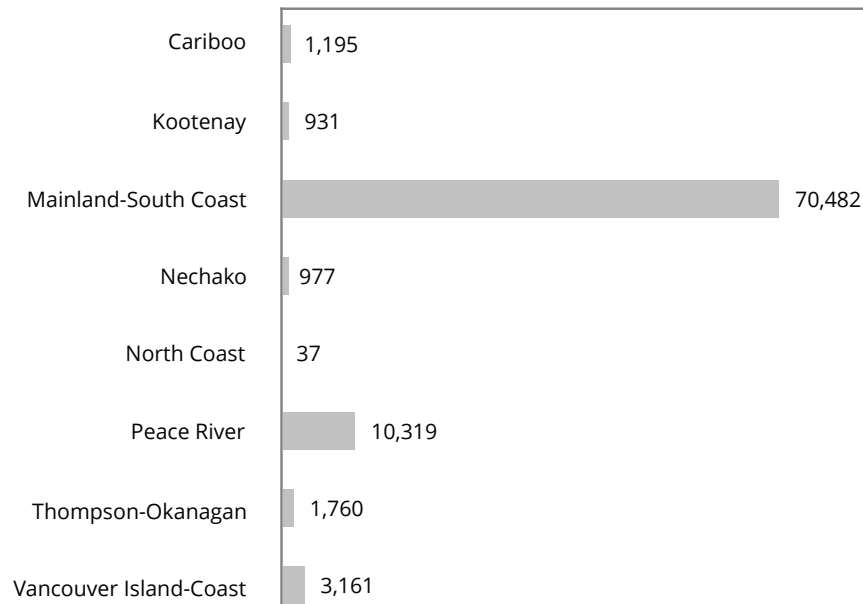
Cattle and Calves (number of animals)

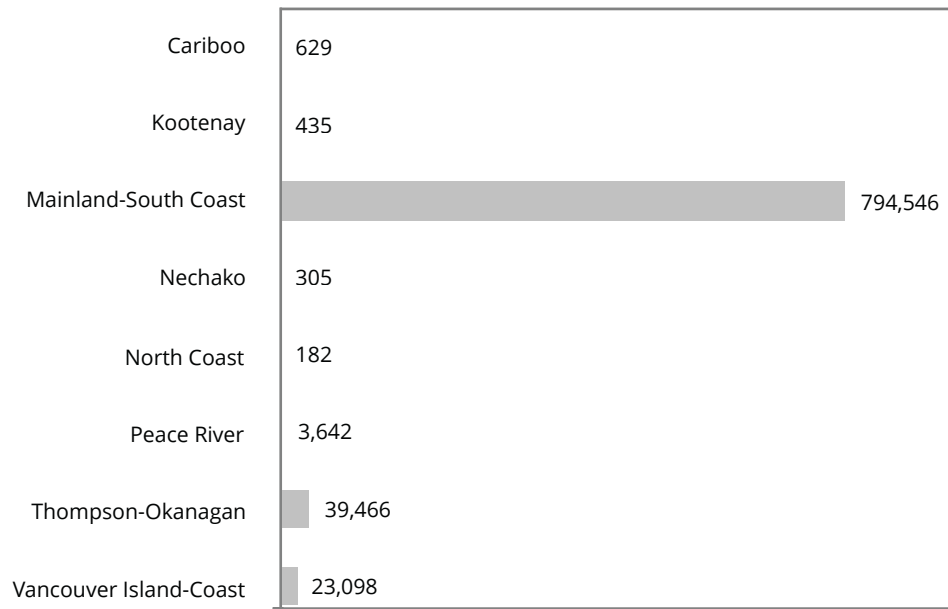
Total number of Pigs (number of animals)

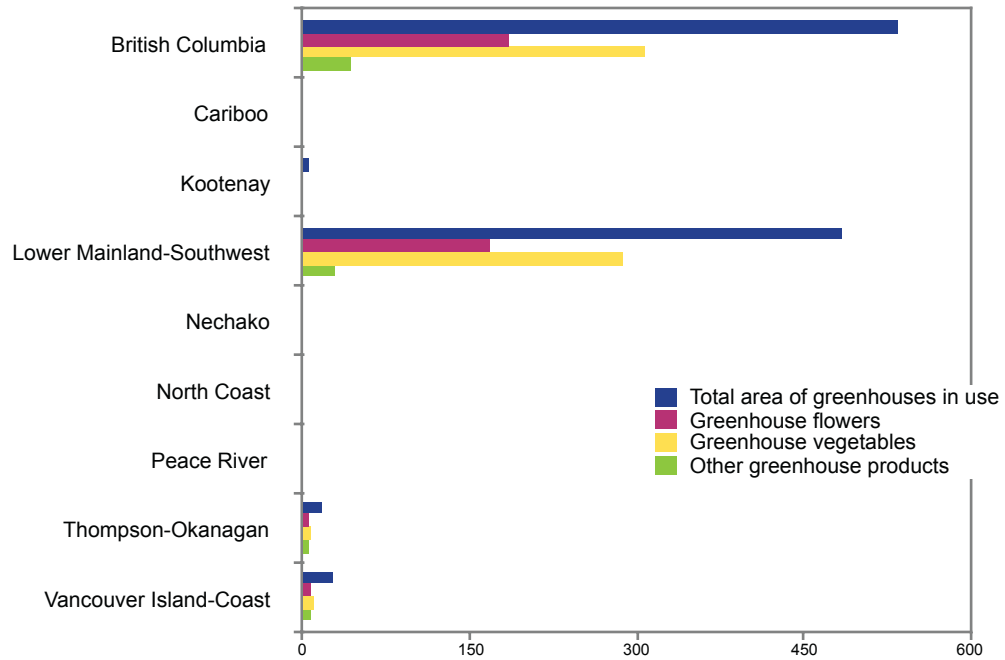


Total number of Turkeys (number of animals)

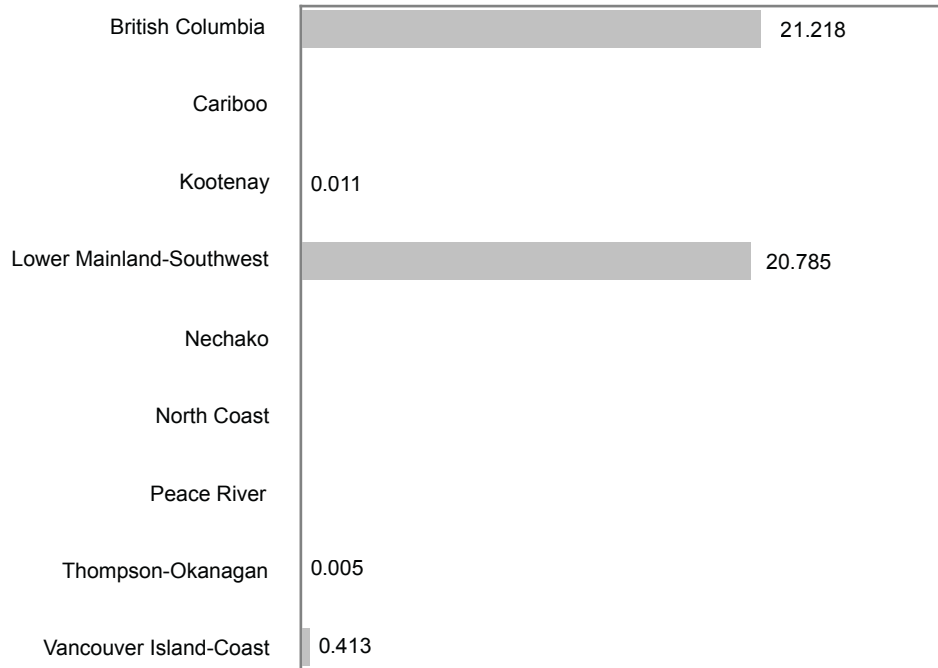

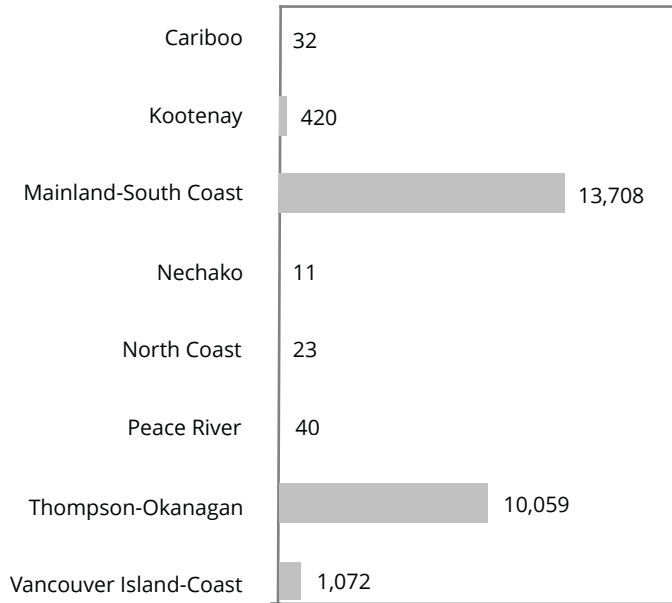
Total Greenhouse Production (hectares)



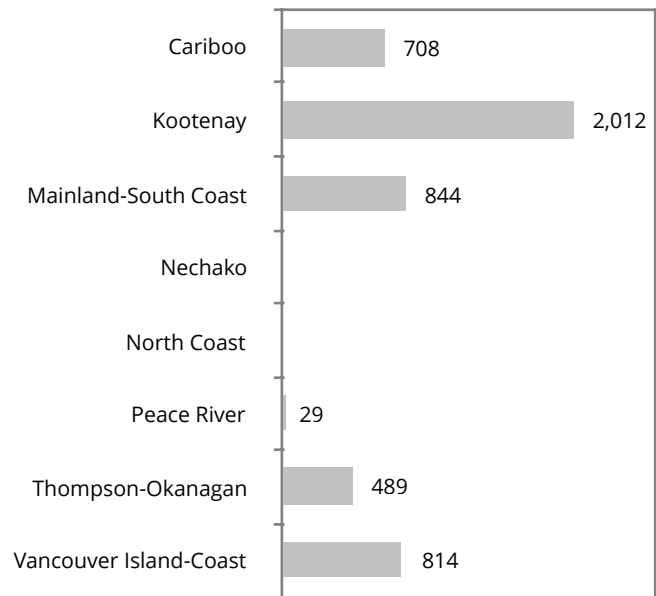

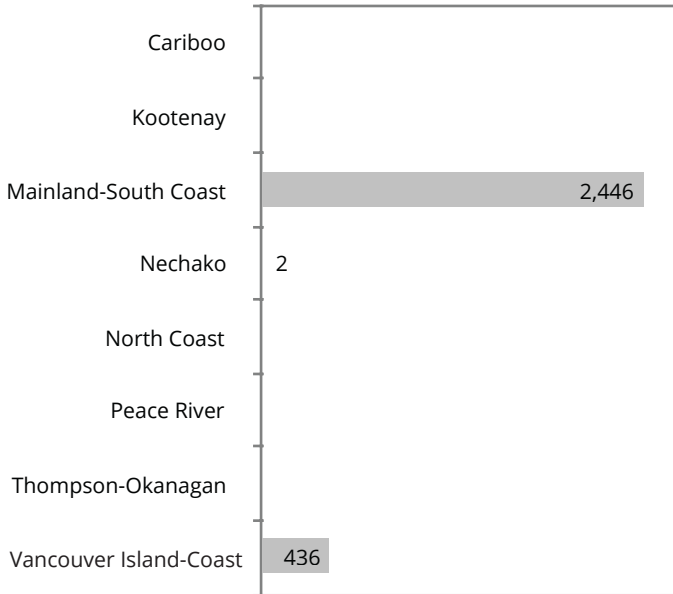

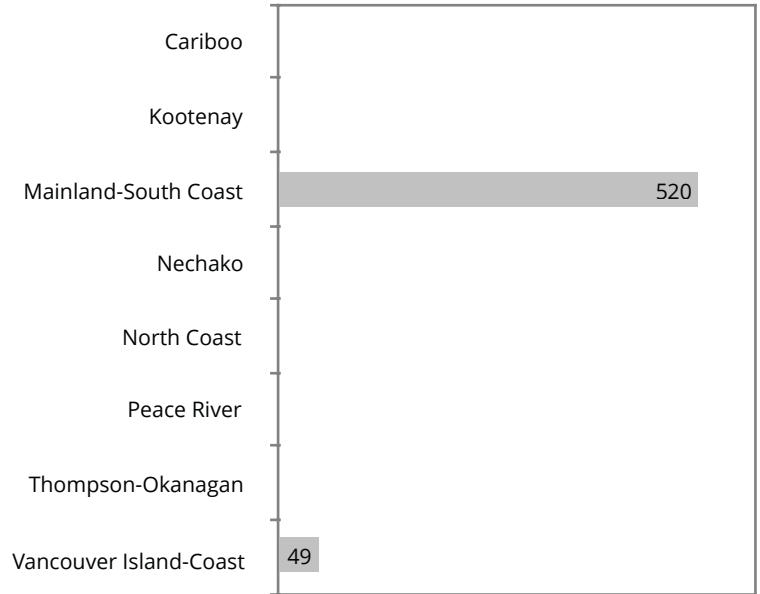
