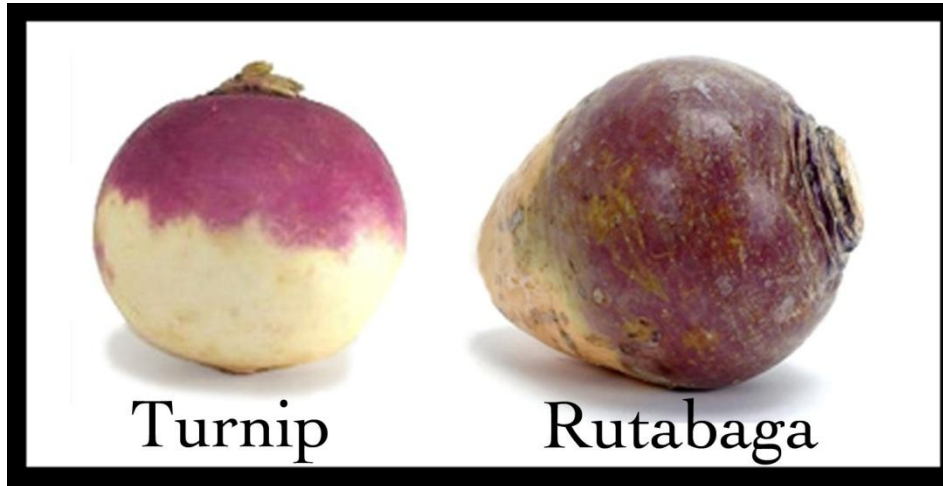

### Rutabaga

| ✓ cool weather crop                       | ✓ cool weather crops  |
| ✗ Base ball size – smaller than Rutabagas | ✗ Soft ball size - bigger than Turnips  |
| ✗ white-fleshed                           | ✗ yellow-fleshed  |
| ✗ Remain whitish after cooked             | ✗ Changes to yellowish-orange after cooking.                                  |
| ✗ Slightly bitter flavour                 | ✗ Slightly bitter - sweet flavour.  |
| ✗ Fine texture                            | ✗ A rougher texture than Turnips  |
| ✗ Turnips have 20 chromosomes             | ✗ tougher and starchier than Turnips  |
| ✗ Food source for ancient Romans          | ✗ Rutabagas have 38 chromosomes   |
|   | ✗ An 18th century invention, which is a cross between a turnip and a cabbage. |
